

Shrines of French Canada

Day 1 Montréal, Canada

Welcome to Montréal. This evening enjoying WELCOME RECEPTION and meet your traveling companions.

Day 2 Montréal

Sightseeing today includes NORTE DAME BASILICA in the old seminary of St. Sulpice. Also visit MAY QUEEN OF THE WORLD CATHEDRAL, a similar version of St. Peter's Basilica in Rome, and DAME-DE-BON SECOURS, one of the landmark sites in Old Montréal. Afterwards one of the trips biggest highlights: a visit to St. JOSEPH'S ORATORY, recognized as one of the world's greatest churches. A tour of the shrine includes viewing the many ex-votos of miraculously cured pilgrims.

Day 3 Montréal – St. Benoit-du-Lac - Québec city

Depart Montréal this morning for a visit to ST. BENOIT-DU-LAC ABBEY, built by Benedictine monks overlooking Lake Memphremagog. Continue to the romantic city of Québec, one of North America's most historic cities at world heritage sites. Enjoy dinner at a local restaurant.

Day 4 Québec City. St. Anne de Beaupre Excursion.

Guided sightseeing includes the spectacular BASILICA-CATHEDRAL NOTRE DAME DE QUEBEC (visit both basilica and crypt). Afterwards visit MONTGOMERY FALLS, one of the most impressive cataracts on the North American continent, and the JERUSALAM CYCLORAMA, the world's largest painting depicting the city of Jerusalem on the day Christ died. Afterwards visit St. Anne DE BEAUPRE, the oldest pilgrimage destination in North America. Visit the museum and see miraculous image of Saint Anne.

Day 5 Québec- City-Cap-de-la-Madeleine – Montréal

Journey to City-Cap-de-la-Madeleine for a visit to the BASILICA OF OUR LADY OF THE ROSARY, one of North America's most famous shrines. View the stunning stained-glass windows, strolled to the grounds of the sanctuary, and see the miraculous Madonna icon before departing for Montréal. This evening enjoy a Globus farewell celebration dinner at a local restaurant.
